Club Welfare & Child Protection

It is acknowledged that there are inherent risks in the sport of gymnastics due to the complex nature of the activities. However, these risks can be minimised by adherence to best practice in coaching.

The Health, safety and Welfare Policy has been designed to enable the Club to meet these obligations.

The coaches owe a general duty to their gymnasts to exercise reasonable care for their safety and well being in both training and competitions.

The BG Code Of Ethics for coaches comprises such values as humanity, relationships, integrity, responsibility, competence, commitment and confidentiality.

The Code of Ethics, The Health, Safety and Welfare Policy for coaches and clubs, The equity Policy and the Child Protection Policy are all available on request from the SAADI Health, Safety & Welfare/ Child Protection Co-ordinator.
